

HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT - Academic Year 2022-2023

As a school we aim to encourage learning by providing a welcoming, happy and supportive environment. We give high priority to clear communication and to a positive partnership with parents. We encourage each member of the school's community to take responsibility for pupil development whilst attending our school, and we rely on the support of parents to achieve these aims. This includes a collective responsibility towards standards of behaviour based on honesty, respect, consideration and responsibility which includes an emphasis on good manners.

Our home school agreement aims to define the support we expect from parents and pupils and what parents and pupils can expect from the school.

The school will:

- 1* Be respectful and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the daily life of the school
- 2* Care for your child's safety and happiness reflecting the values of this school
- 3* Endeavour to ensure that your child achieves his/her full potential as a valued member of the school community
- 4* Provide a balanced curriculum and meet the individual needs of your child
- 5* Aim to maximise the academic potential of each child
- 6* Achieve high standards of work and behaviour through building good relationships and developing a sense of responsibility
- 7* Keep you informed about general school matters and about your child's progress in particular
- 8* Prepare children for secondary school
- 9* The school will not allow a child to go on any trip if their behavior is assessed to be a Health & Safety risk.

Parents/Guardians

I/We shall:

- 10*Treat members of staff with respect
- 11* Treat others as I would wish to be treated
- 12*See that my child attends school regularly, on time (informing the school by 9.30each day if my child is absent) and properly equipped
- 13*Encourage positive attitudes towards school and learning
- 14*Make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour
- 15*Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour
- 16*Support my child in homework and other opportunities for home learning
- 17* Attend parents evenings and discussions about my child's progress
- 18*Get to know about my child's life at the school
- 19*Keep myself informed about general matters at the school by encouraging my child to ensure he/she brings letters home promptly, and by returning paperwork promptly
- 20*Keep the school informed about where I/we can be contacted and provide an alternative daytime contact for emergencies
